



INT'L STUDENTS - DUAL ENROLLMENT FORM

International students in F-1 and J-1 immigration statuses are required by federal regulations to maintain full-time enrollment during the academic year. Full-time enrollment means a minimum of 12 credits for undergraduates and 9 credits for graduate students. If a student wishes to be dually enrolled at USCA and another institution, s/he must take at least 6 credits at USCA. In addition, students are required to have the permission of their academic department/advisor to pursue dual enrollment. Your signature indicates that you are aware of the above guidelines for attendance and agree to provide transcripts to the International Programs Office.

****Please Note: If dropping courses at the other institution makes you less than full time, you will need to be pre- authorized for under-enrollment. You must maintain full time between both institutions in order to keep you legal immigration status.**
