FIVE STEPS

For A Successful ProctorU Experience



STEP 1

Create a ProctorU Account and download the Guardian Secure Browser.

To create a ProctorU Account, sign up using [this link](#).

- Select your Institution's name from the dropdown menu and fill out all the required information before submitting.

Download the Guardian Secure Browser.

- [Click here](#) to download the browser.

STEP 2

Schedule your exam.

Login and click the “**Schedule New Session**” button.

Confirm your institution, term, and exam name, then click “**Search Sessions.**”

Use the **calendar** and **clock** features on the left to select your desired testing date and time.

Note: Please schedule at least 72 hours in advance of the date/time you want to take your exam. If you are unsure of the exam name, please contact your instructor.



STEP 3

Test your equipment.

Click [here](#) to log in to your ProctorU account and test your equipment.

Please test your equipment **before** exam day in an environment that is identical to or close to the location where you are planning to actually take your exam.



STEP 4

Prepare for your exam day.

- ✓ Test in a private, well-lit room with no one else in it.
- ✓ Have a government-issued ID or other institution-permitted ID.
- ✓ Clear your workspace of all materials except those allowed by your instructor.
- ✓ Close all third-party programs and unplug any secondary monitors.
- ✓ Remove any non-religious head coverings, watches, earbuds, and headphones.
- ✓ Ensure your computer passes the equipment test and the Guardian Secure Browser is installed.
