The USC Aiken Art Department invites students to participate in a campus wide juried art exhibition. USC Aiken students are invited to submit their physical artwork to be considered for this exhibition. The exhibition will take place in the Etherredge Center Upper and Lower Galleries.

Eligibility

- Must be a current USC Aiken student
- Artwork must be original and created in the last 3 years

How to Enter

- Artwork must be hand delivered to ETH 141
- Students can enter up to 3 pieces of art
- All artworks must have the entry form securely attached with both parts filled out legibly
- Work must be picked up from ETH 141 after the exhibition
- Work will be judged in two categories: traditional and continuing education students

Guidelines

- Artwork must be dry
- Art on paper should be attached to matte board
- Art on stretched canvas should be wired
- Include display instructions if necessary
- Student work is not insured, however the gallery is equipped with security cameras.
