

Degree map

This chart provides an overview and sequence of courses and degree requirements for all degree options within the Bachelor of Arts – Major in Music (BA-Music) degree.

Most degree options require a minimum of 120 credit hours and can be completed within eight semesters (4 years).

K-12 Choral Teacher Certification and K-12 Instrumental Teacher Certification options require a minimum of 140-144 credit hours and can be completed in nine semesters (4.5 years). The ninth semester consists of an internship in music education (not shown on this degree map). These degree options result in teacher certification through the South Carolina Department of Education.
